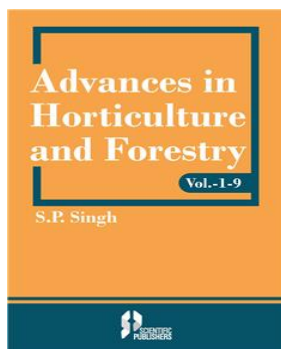


Advances in Horticulture and Forestry (Vol. 1-9)
