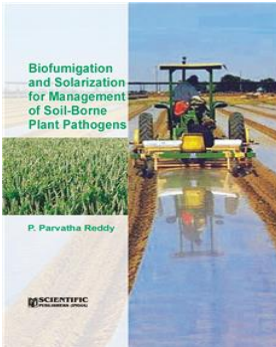


Biofumigation and Solarization for Management of Soil-Borne Plant Pathogens
